Booking Information

By law groups of 6 or more people are not allowed to meet for a social gathering. This rule applies to all ages, both inside the pub and in the beer garden.

If you wish to join us for a drink in the bar or for a meal in the restaurant, your party may contain a maximum of x2 households. We do not take bookings for dining in the garden.

We do not accommodate larger groups who wish to try to work around these new rules by booking multiple tables at the same time.

Cancellation Policy

Due to a spate of guests not showing up for their reservations we unfortunately must now take a £10.00 per person deposit to secure all bookings. This can then either be deducted from the bill at the time of dining or refunded back on to the card. This is refundable up to 48 hours prior to the time of the reservation. All bookings are considered provisional until the deposit is paid.

Allergies & Dietary Requirements

Whilst we follow best practice at all times, we do like to highlight the fact that all the dishes we serve are produced in an environment where allergens are also prepared and cooked. We cannot guarantee that the environment will be completely allergen free.

As a result of this, due to the 'intimate' size of our kitchen we are not able to cater for life-threatening food allergies or restrictions. All other allergies & dietary requirements will be dealt with on a case by case basis to ensure we are guaranteeing you the best possible experience at The Duke's Head.

Vegan Guests
