Red status: birds of high conservation concern. These species have either undergone $\geq 50\%$ decline in UK breeding population or range over the last 25 years, a historical decline from 1800-1995, or are species of global conservation concern.

Amber status: birds of medium conservation concern. These species have undergone a 25-49% decline in breeding population or range in the UK during the last 25 years or have unfavourable conservation status in Europe.

Green status: birds of lower conservation concern.
